Understanding Cards: Credit vs. Debit

As you grow older, your financial options and responsibilities also grow. Right now, your purchases most likely involve cash or coins; however, many adults use other options, such as cards. SECU offers both debit and credit cards, and it's good to know the difference!

A debit card is linked directly to a checking or CashPoints® Global account. When a purchase is made with a debit card, the money is taken out of the account. You can only spend what is in the account, so debit card users must be very responsible and know how much is available in the account before making a purchase.

A credit card purchase is very different. With a credit card, you are borrowing money that you will have to pay back later to buy something now. Using a credit card also requires a lot of responsibility because you should not spend what you can't pay back when it's due. However, when the credit card bill is paid on time, there is an added benefit of building credit. As you get older, good credit can help with borrowing for bigger purchases like a car or a house!

Be creative and enjoy some wintertime fun inside or out!


